

Job Description



Title: Sunday School Teacher

Purpose:

To help prepare children's hearts and minds to receive Jesus Christ as their Savior.

Statement of Accountability:

As a teacher, you commit to serving as a part of a teaching team for the fall through the spring. Teaching teams divide up responsibilities so that you will teach one week, assist the next week and have the third week off. For the weeks you are leading a session, plan for two hours of preparation time and about 45 minutes of teaching time with the children on Sunday morning.

Works With:

Education Ministry Team Leader and Ministry Team as well as co-leaders.

Responsibilities:

- Nurture children's spiritual growth and transformation in cooperation with their parents/guardians, and the rest of the church community.
- Plan Sunday morning sessions in cooperation with the other members of your teaching team.
- Lead Sunday morning session, or assist that week's lead teacher.
- Attend training sessions when offered.
- Pursue your own personal spiritual growth.
- Know the names of the children in your class.
- Have fun!
